



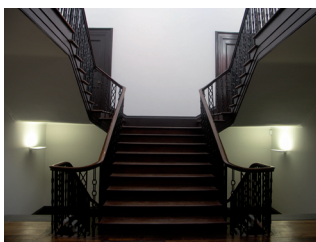
## Ceritech Audio proudly presents a Home Entertainment Experience – A one-day event promoting all things audio-visual.

## About Shire Hall

The Shire Hall where the council now meets was erected in 1724 on the site of the Elizabethan market hall which it replaced. The building was designed to house two "Courts of Judicature" and a room for the Grand Jury at Assizes and Sessions. One of the most famous trials held there was in 1840 and that of the leaders of the Chartists, originally condemned to death but subsequently granted transportations to Van Diemen's Land (Tasmania).

Now classified a Grade I listed building, Shire Hall has recently undergone a £4.5 million refurbishment and is now used predominantly for community activities as well as housing the Monmouth Tourist Board.
